Local school divisions are banking on summer school to help mitigate learning loss. Typically, students lose three to six months over summer break however, according to national studies, the pandemic has increased this loss to an additional seven to nine months across the country. This summer school experience will be most important for those who have been out of the

classroom for the majority of this past school year. But kids can't learn if they are hungry.

## Park View Community Mission's Food for Thought Program needs YOU!

As the numbers for this year's summer school attendance have more than doubled, our efforts to making sure kids are fed over the weekends also needs to multiply.

During a typical summer, Park View Community Mission has packed and delivered 600-weekend food bags filled with meals and snacks to sustain a child throughout the weekends. This summer, that number could be more than 1,500 bags.

In order to meet this need **each week**, Park View will need:

- » \$9,000 per week in monetary or food donations to cover the cost of the bags,
- » Hundreds of volunteers to help sort and pack the food bags,
- » Dozens of drivers to deliver the bags to schools,
- » And many more volunteers to help distribute them to students.
